

Medium garden houses

Medium houses are great for storing away garden tools or for protecting them against rain, wind or other forms of precipitation. They are easy and quick to assemble. The houses are made from strong northern spruce timber, and the corners of their walls come with decorative millwork.

Timbers

Made from 45 mm spruce timber.

Floor

Includes an impregnated foundation and floor joists (impregnation protects wood from undesirable environmental effects: bugs, the sun's rays, fungus, rotting, etc.), together with 20 mm thick floorboards from strong northern spruce wood. The foundation and the floor joists fitted together with screws.

Doors

The doors are made with wooden boards and have a lock. Made from glued pine timber. The door glass contains insulated glass units. The door trims are featureless.

Windows

The turn & tilt windows are made from triple-layered glued-laminated pine timber and come with 14 mm insulated glass units and glazing bars. Include high-quality "Roto" hinges. The window trims are featureless.

Roof

The bargeboards are featureless. The rafters are made from glued-laminated timber (which increases their resistance to heavy loads). The roof construction has been designed for medium roof covering.

Terrace

Medium garden houses can include a terrace. The terrace boards are impregnated, 30 mm thick and laid on top of an impregnated foundation and floor joists. Can be optionally furnished with railings.
